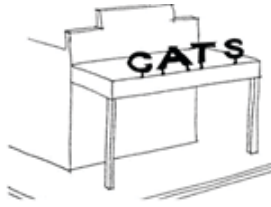
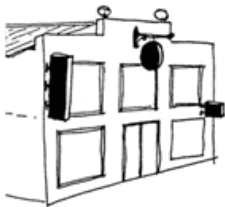

SIGNAGE

Many types of signs within the Shire require Development Approval ('DA', which is planning consent). The Shire has a Local Planning Policy for signage which exempts certain signs from needing Development Approval, and provides guidance to developers regarding what is acceptable and where.

The Local Planning Policy is "SDev CP084" on page 239 of (link) the Shire's 2020 Council Policy Manual.



VERGE OR ROAD SIGNS

Signs that are not within a lot and are within a road verge or any other part of a road reserve do not need a DA, but will need approval from the Shire's Infrastructure Department - call 9724 0000.

OBJECTIVES...SIGNS THAT:

- are appropriate for their location, having regard to the land, the buildings and the surrounding area
- are not excessively large compared to the buildings and the lot size/frontage
- only advertise services and products sold or made at the site, or approved uses at the site. The Shire does not support signs on a lot for businesses on a different lot
- are safely designed and located for pedestrians and drivers
- are simple, clear, easy to read & maintained to a high standard. This may include combining signs on the same lot, rather than having many individual signs.

APPLICATION FOR DEVELOPMENT APPROVAL - SIGNS

All application forms & fees are available on the Shire's website: Forms & Fees. The minimum requirements for applications for advertising signs are:

- Completed Form 110 'Application for Development' and
- Completed Form 110B 'Supplementary Form - Advertising Signage Application'
- All information outlined in the checklist attached to the Application for Development Approval (Form 110), including titles, detailed and dimensioned plans, and a written explanation of the proposal
- Plans showing the artwork must be included and must be drawn to a professional standard
