**CATS TO BE REGISTERED:
(Section 5 CAT ACT)**

The owner of a cat that has reached 6 months of age must ensure the cat is registered with the local government in whose district the cat is originally kept. Penalty: a fine of \$5000.

**CATS TO WEAR COLLARS
AND REGISTRATION TAGS:
(Section 6 CAT ACT)**

A cat shall not be in a public place unless:

- (a) it is wearing a collar to which the valid registration tag is securely attached;
- (b) the name and contact telephone numbers of the owner and the name of the cat are legibly endorsed or inscribed on, or an attachment to, the collar worn by the cat.

**OWNERSHIP:
(Section 8 CAT ACT)**

A person must be over 18 years of age to be the registered owner of a cat. Owner includes the registered owner or the person by whom the cat is ordinarily kept.

**CHANGES IN REGISTRATION:
(Section 13 CAT ACT)**

Where a cat is registered with a local government and the owner moves to another local government area, the owner may notify both the former and the new local government to continue that period of registration with the new local government.

**CATS TO BE MICROCHIPPED:
(Section 14 CAT ACT)**

The owner of a cat that has reached 6 months of age must ensure that the cat is microchipped, unless the cat is exempt from microchipping.

**CATS TO BE STERILISED:
(Section 18 CAT ACT)**

The owner of a cat that has reached 6 months of age must ensure that the cat is sterilised by a veterinarian, unless the cat is exempt from sterilisation

**ONLY APPROVED CAT BREEDERS
MAY BREED CATS:
(Section 36 CAT ACT)**

A person must not breed cats unless the person is an approved cat breeder.

**ON THE SPOT FINES:
(Section 62 CAT ACT)**

Authorised persons can issue infringement fines for contraventions of the Cat Act and council local laws.

CANCELLATIONS:

Cat registrations can be cancelled by the Local Government for two or more offences including infringement fines in any one registration year.
