Michael Bennett	<p>SP 59 of 2017</p> <p>Panel's findings The Panel finds that Cr Harris has breached regulations 7(1)(a) and 11(2) of the <i>Local Government (Rules of Conduct) Regulations 2007</i>, however did not breach regulation 8(b). Cr Harris therefore committed two minor breaches.</p> <p>At its meeting on 25 January 2018, the Panel found that Councillor Laurance Daniel Harris (known as Councillor Danny Harris), a Councillor for the Shire of Dardanup (Shire) committed a breach of regulation 7(1)(a) of the <i>Local Government (Rules of Conduct) Regulations 2007</i> (WA) (<i>Regulations</i>) by improperly sending an email to the President of the Shire (President) on each of 20 and 21 November 2017 (Emails) in the lead up to an ordinary council meeting on 22 November 2017 (Meeting) to gain an advantage for the Eaton Boomers Football Club (Club).</p> <p>At its meeting on 25 January 2018, the Panel also found that Cr Harris breached regulation 11(2) of the <i>Regulations</i> by failing to disclose at or before the Meeting an impartiality interest, being an interest in the Club.</p>	<p>Councillor Laurance Daniel Harris, a Councillor for the Shire of Dardanup, be publicly censured in terms of the Attached Order: https://www.dlgsc.wa.gov.au/docs/default-source/local-government/minor-breach-findings/59-of-2017---reasons-for-decision-and-order.pdf?sfvrsn=ada704c3_1</p> <p>Councillor Harris undertake training in relation to the subject of disclosure of interests.</p>
