Community Engagement Projects

Ms. Lucy Owen- Conway – Manager Place and Community Engagement

- **Eaton Drive Mural Wall – project update and theme exploration.**

Ms Lucy Owen-Conway provided an update on the mural wall. The location has been endorsed by Council and the Shire is awaiting the outcome of the grant funding application before proceeding.

Suggestions were called for on the theme and type of artwork that should feature on the wall. Suggestions included: Cultural significance e.g. river serpent, flora and fauna, possums, blue wrens, not be too distracting due to the traffic volumes on Eaton Drive, low landscaping to be planted in front of the mural, incorporate elements which allow for expansion of the mural in the future. The local schools can also be approached to make it a community project.

It was also suggested to look at retaining the area due to the ground slope and also check for any underlying sewerage connections.

- **Enlighten 2022 – Event Update**

The Enlighten 2022 Event has been postponed until October 2022 due to ongoing COVID uncertainty. The new October date will coincide with Mental Health Week which ties in with the theme of “What Brightens Your Mood?” Submissions of artwork can still be made.

- **East Millbridge Playground**

State Government election funding commitment. Condition of funding that it be a playground aimed at 0-4 year olds. Public consultation is open via Social Pinpoint, closes 27 February 2022.

The Advisory group discussed options and ideas for what should be included. Ideas included: Shade (sails and trees), keep it simple for that age group, equipment you can move through and interact with, swings and climbing, nature play theme.

Ms Vicki Pretorius gave an overview of the land, it is privately owned and allowances need to be made for this land to be developed in the future.

- **Eaton/Millbridge Master Plan and Place Plan**

Mrs Suzanne Occhipinti, Strategic Planning Officer, provided an overview of the plans. The current plans are out of date and are not integrated with each other. The new plans will be evolving documents, more user friendly and consolidating all of the individual plans.
