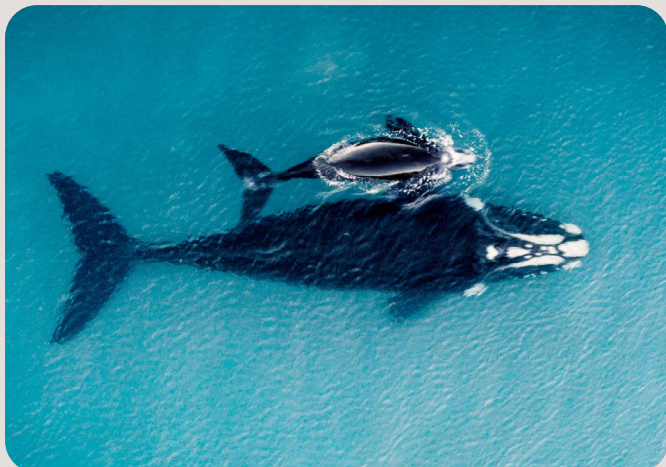

Bookings essential for both sessions.



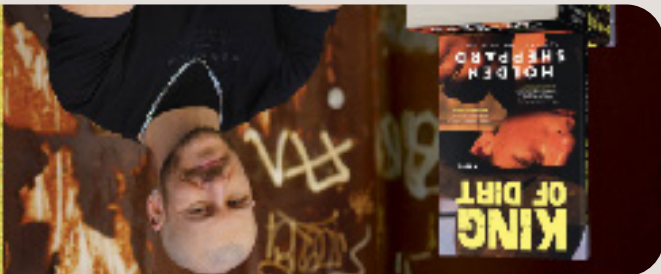
